At the Kitimat Museum summer programs, kids learn about local history, geology, culture, and animals. Activities include hands-on crafts and games, and visits from guest speakers.

Programs are split into two age groups for age-appropriate peer play

- 4 to 6 years: 10:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
- 7 to 9 years: 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

A registration form will need to be filled out when signing up. Forms can be downloaded from the Museum website (kitimatmuseum.ca) and pre-filled or picked up at the Museum front desk.

Cost

- Each program is \$7.00. Programs are run on a daily basis. Sign up for one, or several throughout the summer.
- With a family membership, (\$14/yr), program cost is discounted 15% to \$5.95
- Payment is due upon registration; no holds.
